

IRIS Release Notes

IRIS General
Description
<p>28422 - Quick Search cases do not show up in Recently Viewed Cases list: Fixed.</p>
<p>28520 - Advanced Search enhancement: The Case Process Status dropdown contained long descriptions – these have been changed to the shorter status names that users are accustomed to see. Also, the Advanced Search screen now defaults to "Active" cases.</p>
<p>28336 - Export loan files date range issue: Previously, when an end date was specified, the cases that were returned did not include those that arrived on that end date. This has been resolved.</p>
<p>27755 - Change to data type in preparation for WRAPS 6.0: The UNHCR Case number data type was changed to varchar(30) to be in compliance with WRAPS 6.0.</p>
<p>27114 - BioData import VOLAG Note: When a case is created from a WRAPS BioData file, it now creates a VOLAG Note to record that fact. The new note also includes the name of the BioData file that created it, which will help the VOLAG staff troubleshoot any import issues. In addition, when BioData updates are processed, the existing VOLAG Note that is created will now also contain the name of the BioData file that caused the update to occur.</p>
<p>26341 – “FFY Arrival by Affiliate” report logic: When the VOLAG ran this report, it was not capturing all arrivals for the Fiscal Year, and did not match other similar reports. The logic in this report has been updated to make it correct.</p>
<p>27703 - Define R&P case pool types that require a 180-Day Report: Database was changed to allow an administrator to identify the pool types that do (and do not) get 180-Day Reports.</p>

R&P Pre-Arrival
Description
<p>28986 - Saving Interest without completing required field: IRIS was allowing users to save an interest file record with no Home State, even though this is a required field. This has been fixed so that the user must complete this field.</p>
<p>28948 - Assurance notification formatting changes: In the “Assurance Date Approaching,” “Assurance Date Passed,” and “ALL Cases to be Assured” online notifications, the Case Type column was removed (since all are Refugee type), and a new Assurance Type column was added to indicate “New”, “Amended”, or “Waived”.</p>

R&P Pre-Arrival

Description

27625 - Deleted individual showing on Assurance screen: When an anchor was deleted, s/he was still appearing on the Assurance screen, along with the newly confirmed anchor. IRIS now shows only the correct individual.

28111 - Minor Suitability Determination override: When the VOLAG goes to assure a case, it now has the option of continuing with the assurance even though the Minor Suitability Determination was not submitted.

28983 - Minor Suitability submission bug: When the affiliate submitted a Minor Suitability Determination, IRIS was not always recognizing this and allowing the assurance process to proceed. This has been fixed in this release.

28182 - Allow only one confirmed, primary cosponsor: IRIS was showing multiple confirmed cosponsors on the Assurance Details tab. This has been fixed, so that only the primary confirmed cosponsor appears and is sent to RPC.

28702 - Target Assurance Due Date issues: The target assurance due date that was calculated by IRIS was not always correct. A new process has been incorporated to allow importing of the Allocation Results WRAPS file in order to update the due dates for expedited cases and to exactly match RPC expectations.

26990 - Sorting of anchors by Resettlement Preference: In IRIS, anywhere that anchors or possible anchors are listed, they should be in order of resettlement preference.

R&P Travel

Description

28605 - “No Final Booking” notification enhancement: This VOLAG notification has been modified to include the projected arrival date, so that users can see how urgent a given situation is.

26850 - Highlight Overnight Flights: For most cases, the Arrival Date and the date they arrive at their final destination are the same. However, when a case is scheduled to arrive at its final destination on a day following its arrival at the Port of Entry, this final flight leg is now highlighted on the Travel tab of the case.

28519 - Set focus on travel screens: When the VOLAG travel coordinator navigates to the Travel Notices or Travel Search screens, s/he previously had to move the mouse and click on the field to enter a ProFlight. Now, when these screens are opened, the cursor automatically highlights the ProFlight field to allow immediate typing.

28947 False “Travel Update” notifications: Previously, when the VOLAG user went into a travel screen and updated the Country Traveling From field, this would generate a “Travel Updated” notification. From the affiliate user perspective, nothing had actually changed. In this release, updating the country will not generate a travel notification.

R&P Post-Arrival

Description

29204 - 90-Day and 180-Day Report fund disbursement explanation: Previously, an affiliate explanation was required when the exact per capita amount of \$425 was not spent. This has been changed to require an explanation only when AT LEAST \$425 per person was not spent. The change was in response to the recent increase allowed by the State Department.

28803 – Employment Statistics fix: IRIS was not clearing the employed indicator if a user first selected Employed and then selected Out migrated. This caused incorrect employment percentages to be generated. In this release, IRIS clears all contradictory selections – Employed, Exempt, Out migrated.

29532 - 90-Day and 180-Day Report financial totals: Change logic so that only funds disbursed in the first 90 days appear on the 90-Day report and only funds disbursed in the first 180 days appear on the 180-Day report.

Matching Grant

Description

28973 - Reporting year calculated at MG case enrollment: When an affiliate initially enrolls a case in the MG program, the Reporting Year will be automatically populated. It can then only be changed by a VOLAG user.

28522 - MG Finance Tab Category field change: When entering MG expenditures, the category dropdown is too short to see the entire value on one line. In this release, the dropdown field has been extended.

28774 - 180-Day Reports incorrectly showing as due: When a case does not require a 180-Day report due to its status at the 120th day, IRIS was still showing the case in the 180 Day Report Due notification. In this release, when a case does not require a 180-Day Report, it will no longer appear in this notification.

28401 - Current Affiliate not always displayed: For cases that have been placed with more than one affiliate, some 180-Day Reports were displaying the prior affiliate, not the current one. This has been resolved.

28972 - Formatting changes on the MG-1: The Case Number column has been narrowed; The case type designator for non-refugee cases, which has previously appended to the case number, is now in its own column.
