

IRIS Release Notes

Version 3.0– Released 1/21/09

General
Description
Reconciliation mismatches due to biodata import data without leading zeros: Fixed.
Users with sub-office permission does not see notifications for sub-offices: Fixed.
Incorporate new standard dropdown controls: The new dropdown will allow the user to type part of the desired list item and have the list select it. Items can still be selected by mouse click, as well.
Restructuring of Case Notes: Case notes now have only the choices that make sense in a particular phase of the case. However, a user can print all case notes from any case phase region or select one note type (R&P, MG, etc).
Notification permissions logic: Logic for controlling notifications has been improved. Also, changes to ground transport in travel will generate the notice that travel was updated.
Searching for Case or Alien Numbers that begin with zero: Numbers with one or more leading zeros can be found in Advanced Search without entering the leading zeros. This allows for quicker and more accurate searching.
Affiliate Maintenance Changes: Improved layout and ability to add R&P and MG goals for reporting purposes.
Move Online Notifications in to Categories: Layout enhanced to improve grouping and ordering of notifications in the dashboard.
Tab structure changes and hide inactive tabs instead of graying out: Tabs are set up to better reflect the case phases. Tabs that are not needed for a phase or case type are hidden to allow users to navigate more easily through the system.
Able to Access Ad Hoc Reports from Dashboard screen: with proper permission, users can run Ad Hoc Reports created in Report Builder, directly from the Report screens in IRIS.
Employment Reports not working in Report Builder: fixed

Pre-Arrival
Description
"No Final Travel" notice is not working as expected: Travel with no domestic leg and their domestic flight is not the final destination will send a notice that no final travel is booked.
Port of Entry Designation: "Point of Entry" can only be selected for an international flight and only one flight can be designated POE.
Report - FFY Arrival by Affiliate report logic change: Logic changed to match Arrived/Pended Case report. Also, Arrivals Summary By Affiliate and Case Type, Arrivals Summary by Office and Case Type and Arrivals Summary by Region and Case Type will show individual counts instead of cases

Travel updating allowed on closed case: In Travel Notices, under Members, the user cannot edit or remove for closed cases. When trying to add a closed case, the user will get a message that the case is closed and must be reopened to add or edit travel. The "Add" checkbox will be grayed out under Final Booking, for closed cases.
Error Accessing Travel Day Approaching Dashboard Notification: When two flights are designated "POE", the user was getting an error accessing the dashboard notice. Now, old cases will not break and new ones won't allow two flights to be "POE".
Assurance report contains hard coded name: The Volag can now set up a variable to hold the Assurance report signature name. It was hard coded into the report before this release.
Arrival time does not update when changing arrival date on a flight: Now changing the arrival date on the POE flight will update the case arrival date.
CoSponsor data not being exported with Assurance File: fixed

Post-Arrival
Description
Job Termination Reason field allows longer string than db: Now shows an appropriate message instead of an application error.
Predestined SIV cases not included in R&P 180 Day Report Notification: fixed

Matching Grant
Description
New Financial tab in new Matching Grant section of IRIS: Streamlined capture of case financial data.
Ability to print MG 120/180 Day reports: The user can print each report from its screen.
Trimester locking is based on arrival date and does not consider enrollment date: When the user enters the enrollment date, IRIS will evaluate whether or not the user is trying to add to a previous period. If the enrollment date is after the trimester end date, it should be allowed. Otherwise, no.
Affiliate Name not always most recent: The 180 day report was not showing the most recent affiliate name, if the case had been assigned to more than one over its history. This has been fixed.
No employable members message: Grammar has been corrected in the message.
